Failure to register and pay the applicable registration fee by this deadline may result in the withdrawal of the presentation from the Conference Programme. In such cases, the Conference organiser reserves the right to reassign the presentation slot or session to another contribution without further notice. The submission and acceptance of an abstract or paper do not replace the obligation to register for the Conference.



General Registration Conditions
